Guidelines for M.Th. Departmental Examination (Old Testament)

Candidate applying for the admission to M.Th. in the field of Old Testament is required to Pass Entrance Examination on 26th February, 2021 and clear a Personal Interview conducted by the faculty of the Old Testament Department.

The Entrance Examination consists of 3 Papers: **Old Testament Departmental exam, English, and General Knowledge**. Candidate must secure a minimum of B grade (60%) in all these papers to be considered for Admission.

The Departmental Exam will be conducted online in Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) format. In preparation for the examination, the candidate is advised to read the following books and be familiar with the following biblical texts in Hebrew:
