ENGLISH LANGUAGE

Time Allotted: 1 hour Total marks: 50

Grammar (20 marks)

Vocabulary (10 marks)

This part of the exam will contain questions to test the ability of the candidate to utilize the right words in sentences, understand the meaning of the words in context and identify the common spelling mistakes. (**Types of Questions**: Multiple Choice Question and Fill in the Blanks)

Comprehension (20 marks)

This will assess the ability of the candidate to read the short and medium length academic writings quickly and comprehend the overall meaning of the text and its argument. (**Type of Questions**: Multiple Choice Question)
